

# Dubrovnik tour **May 21, 2018**

## A town that leaves nobody unmoved

Departure by coach from hotel at **9am** with guide into the direction of Dubrovnik, Croatia.

On the way to this city you will be breathless from the beautiful landscapes of Boka Bay.

We will cross the border in Dubrovnik, driving into the direction of the Old Town.

There will be stops for panoramic views, where you can enjoy views of Old town and surroundings.

The patron saint of the city is **Sveti Vlaho (Saint Blaise)**. His statues can be found all around the city. One of the larger churches in city is named after **Saint Blaise**. The city boasts of many old buildings, such as the Arboretum Trsteno, the oldest arboretum in the world, dating back to before 1492. Also, the third oldest European pharmacy is located in the city, which dates back to 1317 (and is the only one still working today).

Visiting the Old town you can see the King's palace, Franjo's monastery (the old pharmacy from 14th century), Dominican's monastery, the Cathedral and Onofrio's fountain.

Free time for lunch and shopping.  
Drive back to Montenegro, arrival to hotel around **7pm**.
